
Live server application examples

- * Possible to relay the live video of supervision to other school, shared lecture among affiliated schools, culture exchange.
- * Our own compression format : KAM is very small in data size compared with general video compression technology like MPEG, etc., line stress is reduced during file transfer, and security is enhanced though dedicated playback software is required.
- * Bi-directional video/voice communication is possible through communication between 2 sets "LsBox" connected
- * Basic operation is done by PC, and possible to play the specific part of captured video for checking/confirming
 As the captured video is saved on PC, quite simple to arrange a library by saving the video on large storage media
 (like DVD) for file backup
